## City of New Lisbon 2019 Yard Waste, Garbage & Recycling and Large Item Pickup

## YARD WASTE

<u>Yard waste pickup will be every Monday, starting Monday, April 1<sup>st</sup> until November 11<sup>th</sup>. Yard waste (grass clippings, flowers, leaves etc.) shall be placed in <u>paper</u> yard bags by the curb. *Do not use plastic bags*. After October 30<sup>th</sup>, rake leaves only to the curb for the City to vacuum. There is no leaf pickup in the spring.</u>

<u>Brush & tree limb</u> pickup also starts April 1<sup>st.</sup> Limbs must be cut into 4-foot lengths and be securely tied in bundles not to exceed thirty (30) pounds or they will not be picked up. Tree trunks & stumps are to be removed by the owner. Excessive amounts of limbs will be billed an hourly labor and equipment charge. Please contact the Director of Public Works to arrange pickup. Contractors are responsible for removal of any limbs they cut; otherwise they will be billed for removal. Brush pickup will end the week of November 11<sup>th</sup>.

## **GARBAGE & RECYCLING**

Lenorud Services, Inc. will collect garbage and recycling on Thursdays. Please have trash and recycling to the curb by 7am. All garbage should be bagged. Garbage includes normal household items. This service is not for house clean outs or demolition/remodeling projects. You may also access our website for more information at www.lenorudservices.com

The following is a list of what can be recycled and how to properly prepare it for pick up. All single-stream recycling may be placed together in a clear plastic bag (no larger than 30 gallon) or in a bin of your choice labeled "Recycling".

<u>All Cardboard</u> must be flattened, no waxed cardboard.

<u>Mixed Paper</u> includes all grades of paper: including white, colored, ledger, shiny coated, carbonless or NCR papers, envelopes (including windowed, labeled, and Kraft), Magazines, phone books, computer printout paper, glued pads and notebooks, cereal boxes, shoe boxes, etc. Does not include: paper towels or other paper products from restrooms or soiled napkins, paper plates and Styrofoam cups, carbon paper, cellophane or any waxed paper.

<u>Plastics (all numbered plastics)</u>, <u>container glass, tin and aluminum</u>. It does not include: plastic grocery bags, ceramic cups, dishes, ovenware, plate glass, safety and window glass, heat –resistant glass such as Pyrex, lead based glass such as crystal or TV tubes.

**ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED FOR PICKUP AT ANY TIME**: freon units, yard waste/brush, paint in a liquid state, oil, hazardous waste, friable or non-friable asbestos.

**LARGE ITEMS -** the large item pickup will also be handled by Lenorud. The large item collection will be every Thursday. This will need to be paid for in advance by check or credit card. Please call <u>608-847-2147</u> for more information. This includes electronics, tires, and batteries.

## DROPPING ITEMS OFF AT JUNEAU COUNTY LANDFILL

As an alternative to having Lenorud pick up your large items, you may take them directly to Juneau County Landfill. The landfill is located at W7611 Ceylon Road and is open Monday-Wednesday-Thursday 8:00 A.M. – 3:30 P.M. and Saturday 8:00 A.M. – 12:00 P.M. The tipping fee is \$56 per ton, with a \$5 minimum charge. There are additional fees of \$20.00 for dehumidifiers, air conditioners, refrigerators and any appliance containing Freon; \$15.00 for computer monitors & televisions; \$10.00 for mattresses; \$5.00 for microwaves. The charge for florescent lightbulbs is \$1 each. There is a 10¢ per pound charge for tires. The landfill can be reached at 562-5233 if you have any questions. *All electronics are recyclable.*
